ACTIVITIES AND SITES:

HUNGER:

- Stop Hunger Now is a globally recognized organization whose vision is a "world without hunger."
- Community FoodBank of New Jersey fights hunger and poverty by providing a variety of food assistance and education programs in Hillside.
- Father English Bob and Carol Food Pantry-Catholic Charities is a part of the Catholic Family and Community Services (CFCS) in Paterson.
- Oasis: A Haven for Women and Children provides food, clothing, and education to women and children in poverty in Paterson.

HEALTHCARE/WELLNESS:

 Alaris Health provides short-term post-hospitalization rehabilitation, long-term, and specialty care for a variety of patients.

EDUCATION:

- Passaic Head Start serves approximately 250 children from low-income working families in Passaic.
- Dawn Treader Christian School provides faith-based education for children from kindergarten to eighth grade in Paterson.
- Paterson Museum has a broad collection that encompasses archaeology, mineralogy, and history.

SUSTAINABILITY:

- Buttermilk Falls is a part of the High Mountain Park Preserve on the William Paterson campus.
- Paterson Falls is part of the National Historical Park in Paterson.
- Liberty State Park is an urban park located in Jersey City.
