Submit the "Application to Present at Honors Week 2026" to honors@wpunj.edu. Your Honors Track Director may require additional documentation.

☐ **Deadline 12/01/25**

Submit a photo of yourself to honors@wpunj.edu. Please write "Honors Week Photo" in the subject line.

☐ **Deadline 03/02/26**

Submit a maximum 150-word abstract to honors@wpunj.edu. Please write "Presentation Abstract" in the subject line. Be sure to email a draft of your abstract to your Track Director for approval by 02/23/26.

☐ **Deadline 04/01/26**

Submit a 10-second video of yourself that will be included in a video montage.

☐ **Deadline 04/03/26**

Schedule an appointment with your Honors Track Director to rehearse your Honors presentation.

☐ **Deadline 04/10/26**

Invite faculty members, family, and friends to attend your Honors presentation during Honors Research Week.

☐ **Deadline 04/16/26**

Honors Research Week 2026 will be held in person during the week of April 20-24. Your specific presentation time will be set based on your spring class schedule and other factors. The exact schedule will be set in late January. The public presentation of your thesis is an Honors requirement. NOTE: Presenting at Honors Week is an Honors Requirement and is not negotiable.  - The photo should be a clear, professional headshot. (Avoid cluttered backgrounds or distracting clothing).

Abstract

- A maximum 150-word abstract will be used for the Honors Research Week program

- Subject line: "Presentation Abstract"

Deadline 04/01/26

Video

- 10 second video of yourself
 - Tell us what was best about your track, your favorite Honors College memory, or your overall experience with Honors
- The video will be included in a montage featured at the April Honors Reception
- More information and instructions will be provided in February; submission is optional

Deadline 04/03/26

Presentation rehearsal with your Track Director

- Schedule an appointment with your Track Director
 - Review your PowerPoint Presentation
 - Rehearse your Honors presentation

Deadline 04/16/26

PowerPoint Presentation

- For use during your Honors Week presentation
- All presentations will be set up on a Dell laptop (you must use the equipment that is provided)
 - As a backup, save your presentation to a flash drive and email it to yourself
- Email your **FINAL** PowerPoint Presentation to honors@wpunj.edu AND to your Track Director
- Subject line: "Honors Week PowerPoint Presentation"
- **NOTE – Only ONE submission of your FINAL presentation will be accepted. Make sure to proofread the presentation carefully before submitting it.**

NOTE that your Track Director and the Honors College will provide you with more specific guidance about your presentation in March.

Deadline 05/13/26

Final Thesis Submission

- Submit your Final Thesis to Honors via OneDrive
 - Your completed Thesis Cover Sheet should be included in your thesis as the first page
 - Student signature is required
 - Honors will get the Track Director/Thesis Supervisor and Dean's signatures
- **Follow the specific submission instructions that will be emailed to you in April**
