## Changes -- In a Nutshell

#### Old MSCHE

▶ 14 standards

- PRR (Periodic Review Report) every 5 years
- ▶ Compliance Report
- ▶ 10 year cycle self-study & visit

#### New MSCHE

- ▶ 7 standards
- AIU (Annual Institutional Update) -- every year
- MPPR (Midpoint Peer Review) – every 4 years
- Requirements of Affiliation
- 8 year cycle self-study & visit

## New 7 Standards




## New Requirements of Affiliation

Assure that the institution is eligible for new accreditation or renewed accreditation

- Legal and policy driven
- 15 criteria (examples):
  - Is authorized and licensed to operate
  - Complies with government rules and regs
  - Has a board-approved mission, defines purpose
  - Is operational (has students enrolled)
  - Systematically evaluates academic, other entities and publicizes
  - Follows ethical guidelines (i.e., conflict of interest, etc.)
  - Fully discloses to the accreditation body

## New Annual Institutional Update (AIU)

#### Goal of AIU:

- Yearly measurement of institutional health
- Implement for review of institution by MPPR team

#### Focus:

- Student achievement
- ► Financial Health of the institution
- Contextual documention

## New Mid-Point Peer Review (MPPR)

#### Goal of MPPR:

Review prior 4 years of AlUs; make recommendations

#### Focus:

- Student achievement
- ► Financial Health of the institution
- Attention to issues for improvement raised in previous AIUs
