### COVID-19 Reopening Safety Policy/Code of Conduct

**William Paterson University is committed to minimizing the risk of COVID-19 within our community to promote the health and safety of the community. In order to reduce the risk of transmission, it is expected that all adhere to the public health practices described in this document. All community members have an ethical personal responsibility to ensure that we are following the latest recommendations and protocols.**

**It is therefore required that community members acknowledge receipt of the new protocols for returning to and/or coming to campus. These protocols may be updated as information and guidance evolve, and all members of the William Paterson community will be required to adhere to any such revised protocols. It is the University's expectation that WP community members will, to the best of their ability, promote and adhere to these public health initiatives and procedures.**

**Read and Acknowledge receipt of each requirement for members of the William Paterson community by indicating such:**

\_\_\_\_\_ Maintain social distancing of at least six feet, both professionally and personally.

\_\_\_\_\_ Wear a face covering (that covers both nose and mouth) while in the presence of others, consistent with the WP Social Distancing and Face Covering Policy, while on campus.

\_\_\_\_\_ Participate in daily health screenings and temperature-taking prior to arriving on campus, attending class, or taking part in a WP-sponsored event or activity of any kind. If a community member has a fever of over 100, or answered "yes" to symptoms or exposure, the individual is prohibited from coming to campus and must contact a health care provider.

\_\_\_\_\_ Wipe down work stations/equipment at the beginning and end of the work day. (Beginning of each class and the end of class for faculty and students.)

\_\_\_\_\_ Refrain from coming to campus if not feeling well or if they think they have been exposed to COVID-19.

\_\_\_\_\_ Report appropriately if diagnosed with COVID-19 (Human Resources for employees, Counseling, Health and Wellness for students) due to the necessity of contact tracing and reducing the further spread of COVID-19.

\_\_\_\_\_ Complete a visitor log located at on the Reopening Plan website if hosting campus visitors to ensure that the visitors are aware of the required health practices. This includes wearing a face covering, social distancing, and daily health screenings including a temperature check. Visitors must perform a symptom self-checker prior to coming to campus. This can be found on the CDC website <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/symptoms-testing/symptoms.html>. (As a reminder, no visitors are allowed in the residence halls.)

\_\_\_\_\_ Note that failure to adhere to WP health and/or reopening policies related to COVID-19 may be detrimental to the health and safety of the community. As a result, violations may result in appropriate corrective action consistent with the principles of progressive discipline and not unlike violations of other University policies.
