2022-2023 Summary of Activities:

The focus of this year was on the university budget process and coordination between the Council and other offices and entities involved in planning and finance. Discussion regarding the need for greater transparency related to how the university budget is developed took place throughout the year. Council members discussed the Council's standing charges and ways in which this Council might work effectively to meet these expectations.

The Governance Council's audit of standing charges helped to shed light on the relationship between the work of the Budget and Planning Council and its standing/priority charges. The disconnect between the Council's charges and the work it is able to do is of concern to the Faculty Senate, and it was noted that this Council is unique in its inability to get information and materials to make future recommendations as per the charges.

The Council met with Kirsten Loewrigkeit, the new Vice President of Finance & Administration, and will seek to establish a collaborative partnership with her office going forward.
