Policy and Procedures:

- 1. Review and recommend policies and procedures for strengthening graduate programs, in particular, evaluating the feasibility and need for creating a School of Graduate Studies.
- 2. Review and recommend policies and procedures for evaluating Graduate Program viability (i.e., programs on hiatus).
- 3. Review and recommend policies and procedures for developing a Strategic Plan for Graduate Program marketing and branding that includes a decentralized approach that recognizes individual program needs.
- 4. Graduate Academic, Diversity and Support Group (GAD-SSG)
 Review and recommend policies and procedures for developing, identifying, and coordinating academic, multicultural and social integration resources in order to support and mentor graduate students, including returning and international students as well as students of diversity.
