- Hong vice-chairperson, discussion of university archives, encourage undergrad research;
- Williams, digital repository, figure out what materials store and how to store them for efficient usage. Examples include WP sphere, MIT platform, minutes meetings on board of trustees;
- Online open journal system was mentioned by library;
- Hong, difference between storing and archiving, what exactly is there, who is in charge, what needs to be in place to maintain the archives;
- David, sphere demonstrated;
- Hong, data should be available to faculty and senate, repository is a central hub. Challenges to generate documents in a digital era were discussed;
- Jan, stuff discussed that shortages may get problematic for continuous archiving and other processes;
- Hong, Blackboard shells management is an important issue. Specifically, retrieving, comparing, evaluating, and archiving them;
- Will share with sentate, provost, and president whether or not they will support initiatives next year;
- Discussion of digital measures data
 - How include the undergraduate collaboration in digital measures
 - PhDs in nursing are obligated to present
 - Digital measures are not perfect to capture undergraduate research
 - Explorations forum is a stable option that must be encouraged and included in measurement
- Discussion regarding faculty-student research.
 - Ask professors who work with a lot of undergrad research
 - Honors college is a good target for explorations.
 - Jan sent a flier that demonstrates honors initiative that presents research
 - Dean Andrew is going to come visit our meeting in spring
- Social media, such as Instagram and Twitter, has been discussed as a way to engage and communicate with student population
