In accordance with the state law, William Paterson University is required to offer health insurance coverage for purchase by students who are enrolled full-time. The plan being offered for the Spring 2021 semester is through Aetna Student Health. If you are a new incoming full-time student or if you were part-time for the Fall 2020 semester and became full-time for the spring semester, you were automatically billed for the student health insurance plan. If you have your own personal health insurance provider which meets the requirements, you can waive-out of the Aetna Student Health insurance plan and the charge will be removed from your bill.

You can either waive out, proactively enroll in or learn more information about the plan at <u>https://www.aetnastudenthealth.com/wpunj</u>. Click on <u>Enroll/Waive</u> for video instructions on how to enroll or waive the student health insurance plan. The deadline date to complete the waiver for the Spring 2021 semester is <u>February</u> <u>26, 2021.</u> After the deadline date, you will be automatically enrolled in the Aetna Student Health Insurance Plan.

Make sure you check your WPUNJ email account for an email from Aetna Student Health regarding the status of your waiver or enrollment into the plan.
