

Deadline to waive the Student Health Insurance has been extended to September 30, 2020!!

In accordance with the state law, William Paterson University is required to offer student health insurance coverage to all **full-time** students. The plan being offered for the 2020/2021 academic year is through Aetna Student Health. With this program, the University automatically billed all full-time students for health insurance for the academic year. Full-time students have the opportunity to waive out of this coverage by providing evidence of health insurance by the waiver deadline.

Students are required to either waive out or proactively enroll in the plan. The deadline to waive the insurance has been extended until **September 30, 2020**. Students who have comparable coverage can waive out of the Aetna Student Health Plan by the waiver deadline and the charge will be removed from the bill. After the deadline, students will be unable to waive the insurance plan and will be automatically enrolled in the Aetna Student Health Insurance Plan. **Once enrolled, there are no cancellations or refunds.**
