Am I Eligible for VA Health Care Benefits?

Generally, to be eligible for VA health care you must have been discharged under "other than dishonorable" conditions, e.g., honorable, under honorable, or general. However, if you received other than honorable discharge, you may still qualify based on a determination made by a VA.

If you enlisted after September 7, 1980, or entered active duty after October 16, 1981, to be eligible for VA health care, you must have served at least 24 months of continuous active duty. For Reservists or National Guard members who were Federally activated, you must have served the full period you were called or ordered to active duty.

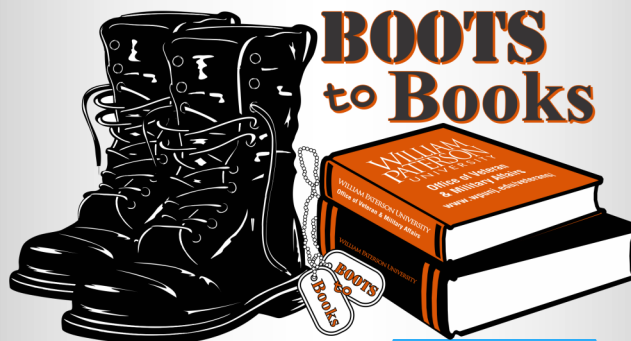
