Health and Well-Being Resources

With VA health care, you're covered for regular checkups with your primary care provider and appointments with specialists (like cardiologists, gynecologists, and mental health providers). Find out how to apply for and manage the health care benefits you've earned at the VA workshop.



A VA Health Care representative will be on campus on March 12th to respond to questions about your health care eligibility or any claims you may have. Check attached flyer.

As a student at William Paterson University, you can utilize the services at the **Counseling, Health and Wellness Center (CHWC)**:

The Counseling Center is staffed with psychologists, social workers, and supervised graduate students. Students are assisted, with identifying and working through personal barriers, normal developmental issues and stressors, and clinical problems which could impede academic success. **There are no costs for counseling services.** It provides a 24 hour emergency counselor service at 973-720-2257.

The Health and Wellness office is staffed by advanced practice nurses (nationally certified nurse practitioners), registered nurses, medical assistants and a physician consultant to provide care for students who are ill or injured. The CHWC is located at Overlook South 1st Floor.

Accessibility Resource Center (ARC) assists students with documented disabilities by providing reasonable accommodations and services that ensures equal access to all programs, activities, and related benefits of the University's educational and professional programs. It provides a range of services to students, based on the impacts of their qualifying conditions: Extended Test Time, Reduced Distraction Environment, Note Taking Services, Adaptive Technology, Classroom Relocation. Your registration status is only shared with faculty/staff on a need-to-know basis.
