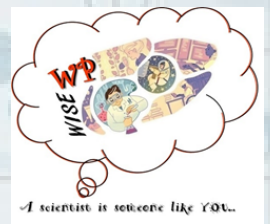

Dr. Morrissette's team characterizes gene mutations and chromosomal abnormalities within cancerous tissues of individual patients for diagnostic, prognostic, and therapeutic purposes. This allows for a more targeted and personalized treatment strategy. Dr. Morrissette has overseen the characterization of thousands of clinical tumor specimens and has implemented a triage for mutations suspected to be germline in cancer predisposition.
