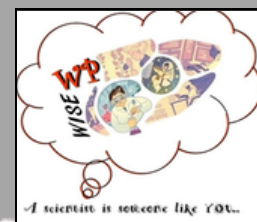

Dr. Jacinto’s research aims to understand how cellular signals are wired to control cellular growth and metabolism. Her group focuses on the cell signaling pathways that respond to nutrients and growth signals. They investigate how stress conditions antagonize these pathways leading to pathological conditions. Their studies have direct implications for understanding and developing therapy for cancer, diabetes, immune-related diseases and aging. In this WISE seminar, Dr. Jacinto will discuss her research and her professional journey.
